

Karunya University opens its third campus at Periyanaickenpalayam in Kovai

Coimbatore, May 25:

Karunya University unveiled its ambitious plans for its future through the launch of a third campus in Coimbatore city limits. In addition to the first campus in Karunya Nagar and second campus in City Center (near Laskmi mills junction), Karunya University's new campus is launched at Periyanaickenpalayam on the Coimbatore Mettupalayam State Highway. The new campus will house a hub of students aspiring to pursue Arts, Science, Humanities, Law and Paramedical programs. Karunya University's plans revolve around transforming the area around Mathampalayam over the next five years to provide new and enhanced facilities for students and also improve the public realm, like offering employability to the villagers.

To begin with, the campus will offer programs in Commerce, Professional Accounting, Computer Applications, Business Administration, Information Technology, Information Security, Digital Forensics and English. Central to the vision for the new campus is a Law Program awaiting a green signal from the Bar Council of India and a 'Paramedical



School for the future', offering courses in partnership with industry to prepare students for the jobs of tomorrow. Research and teaching on this new, future-focused campus will concentrate on the interfaces between disciplines.
